



3:30 Ministries: It's About Time!

- Student's are required to write their testimony in 300 words or less
- Student's are required to be able to communicate their testimony in 3 minutes or less
- Student's are required to initiate 30 second kneel downs. A 30 second kneel down is not intended to slow anyone down or prohibit them from making appointments, etc., however to encourage them and witness as we go. A kneel down is approaching someone and asking if they have a minute. Then, the individual asks if there is anything that they could pray for. Finally, pray with the person you approached right there on the spot, but make sure you only pray for 20-30 seconds. Staying true to your word is important here.



Potty Patrol

- Go to the Dollar Tree for supplies (i.e. rubber gloves, toilet brushes, cleaner, mops, towels, trash bags, etc.)
- Divide youth into groups of at least four (two per gender) and assign them a street in your town.
- As you drive down your assigned street stop every chance you get and ask to clean the bathrooms of doctor's offices, fast food stores, gas stations, etc.
- As you approach the destination it is vital that you look and behave in a presentable fashion! Introduce yourself and tell them who you represent. Make sure you tell them that the purpose of this, although it may be odd, is to let them know that your church loves them, desires to serve them, and is in their community.
- Clean the bathroom quickly and leave. When you are finished cleaning take the trash out to your vehicle and replace with fresh bags. A nice touch is to leave a couple of name tag sized notes that read something like this: "This restroom was clean on 2/8/05 by Ivy Memorial Baptist Church Students as a service to let you know we are in your community."
